The fact that La Carolina was the capital of the New Towns became it one of the most industrious and active centres in the reign of Charles III.






Strategic location

It is located in a **strategic point** concerning the overland communications because it is a door link, as to the North, as to the East.


We are located in the 269 Km of the National A-road (N-IV), specifically in the middles point **between Madrid and Seville**.

It is also considerable to mark the proximity to train shipping and transportation's station in Linares-Baeza (20 minutes).


The connection between our city and the main stations and airports is also fast.

High intensity of cash grants and financial incentives



In La Carolina it is concentrated the highest incentives for the project of creation and modernization of enterprises in their highest percentage, with a wide range of types of assistance: cash grants, direct subsidies, credit facilities, etc.

Eligible items: civil works (service supplies and connections, urbanization and external works, offices, laboratories, social services, buildings production), equipment (processing machinery, special facilities etc.), other investments in fixed assets, materials and project studies.

There are also grants and incentives to companies to: promote stable employment hiring, occupational training for unemployed and employed persons; R + D + i, etc.

The Provincial Council of Jaen support investments in human resources, training and hiring personnel with special grants.

In our province companies that hire 15 or more employees can benefit from subsidy that represent 25%, 35% or 45% of labour costs for 2 years.




Quality of life and leisure
